



CREATE YOUR OWN YO-YO CHRISTMAS TREE



This isn't a project to try to accomplish overnight! Start now and you can have a whole Forrest of yo yo trees for next year.

I used the Clover Yo Yo makers:
Blue (3/4")
Green (1 1/4")
Orange (1 3/4")

There is no definitive way to tell you how many to make...it depends on how you attach them. The original pattern called for a specific size of styrofoam cones, but I went to a dollar store and grabbed what I could find and made them work.

Grab your glue gun and start attaching the yo yos, overlapping them to cover the bald spots. Start from the bottom and be sure to hang them over the edge if you are going to place them on a base. Just have fun and make them pretty. When you get towards the top, take one of your fabric circles and glue that over the top, covering up the end. Continue adding the yo yos til you've covered it.

Now you can have fun decorating it if you'd like to add extra stuff!
